





Ink Pen & Watercolor Workshop

"Lighthouse in Maine"

This class is designed for students (beginner to intermediate) who want to explore using watercolor and waterproof black ink pens.
Students will create an 8" x 10" pencil draft image, use a pen to draw more detail and complete with watercolor for value and color.

All supplies: paper, pens, pencils, reference photos, watercolor and paper are included in the registration fee.

Springfield Art Guild Fall 2024 Virtual Art Show

This show is open to all Guild members and will be exclusively shown on the Springfield Art Guild website. This is an Artist's Choice show. It can be in any medium, style, genre, etc. you wish. Your submitted artwork can be something you just completed or something you did a long time ago. Your artwork cannot have been previously shown in any SAG Virtual show on the website before.

Requirements are listed below.

A People's Choice award will be given out at the November 13, 2024 meeting. A flyer with information on voting will be sent out by the opening of the show for advertisement and how to vote for your favorite piece/s. We encourage you to pass the flyer around to family, friends, etc. to get the word out about the show.

Artwork submitted may be something you painted recently, but can be artwork you've had awhile and hasn't sold. Artwork must fit the theme of this show which is Artist's Choice. Any style, medium, genre, etc. is welcome.



- Only original 2-D and 3-D art, will be considered. Traditional photographs and digitally enhanced photographs are welcome. Drafts, photocopies, offset prints, lithographs, or copies of already published art will not be permitted.
- All artwork can be for sale, but NFS will also be accepted.
- If selected, your artwork will appear in the exhibition from September 28, 2024 to November 30, 2024.
- If your artwork sells, it will be marked on the website as sold and you may proceed with making arrangements to deliver your artwork to the buyer and pay VA sales tax. You will also need to pay a 10% commission fee from your sale payable to SAG. These fees will be used later for awards in our next Juried Virtual show.
- SAG members may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. Only good quality photos taken without the frame will be accepted. Please make sure you crop your photos well, make sure no shine appears and that the photos are in focus. **Any photos that do not meet these criteria will not be accepted.**
- If you submit a diptych or triptych, it will count as one piece of artwork.
- Artists selling their art will be responsible for collecting the money, collecting and paying the Virginia sales tax, and all shipping aspects of purchased artwork. SAG's website does not have e-commerce capability. People interested in purchasing art will be directed to a single SAG point of contact who will then contact the individual artists. Commissions will be paid directly to the Springfield Art Guild no later than December 21, 2024. Send your 10% commission check to the SAG Treasurer Sandy Olszowy at 9009 Golden Sunset Lane Springfield, VA 22153. Please put Attn: SAG on the envelope and on the check please make a note that this commission is from your Virtual art show sale.
- Photographs of art must portray a clear and accurate view of what the piece looks like. Artwork previously shown at a SAG sponsored Virtual show may not be submitted.
- You will be submitting your entries on JotForm. Please follow this link:

 The JotForm for the Fall Virtual Show will direct you to enter your contact details and information about each submission, including title, size, medium, and image. Each image must be renamed before you upload it to the JotForm ("YourLastName_FirstName_Title.jpg"). The jpeg needs to be no smaller than 250KB and no larger than 1MB. Many of you may need to resize your photos. Please email sagcurating@gmail.com with any questions about the JotForm submission process.
- Make sure your membership is up to date. This show is open to all currently paid SAG members.
- In submitting to this show, you are agreeing that you are an active SAG member and you are submitting your own artwork.

For those of you who do not know or have never joined the Open Art Studio, this is a meeting via Zoom where you can paint in your own studio (or anywhere for that matter), talk with and get to know your fellow SAG members, get help from those members (if needed), have a designated time to paint (draw or create) each week and see what others are working on. It is only 1 1/2 hours the 1st and the 3rd Wednesdays of the month starting at 1PM. You can stay for the whole time or just pop in for a quick critique.
