### Sharon Malley Abstracts developed around specific themes such as rivers, the weather, and wind.

Sharon Malley's art practice centers on her care for creation, with her series of abstracts developed around specific themes such as rivers, the weather, and wind.

Her narratives are of a different theme, and began as a response to and reflection of growing up on the Eastern Shore of Maryland during the Jim Crow era, playing with children of migrant workers and tenant farmers on her grandparents' farm. She has expanded on this topic, depicting individuals of different races living in the present day.





Working in her studio on Columbia Pike in Arlington, Virginia, she paints in oil and cold wax on canvas and wood panels, incorporating mixed media materials, and using brushes, stencils, rollers, sponges and other forms of paint application. She has recently begun work in other media, such as silkscreen printing and handmade paper. Her work is shown in galleries and juried exhibits in the DMV and beyond. The theme of her solo show at Touchstone Gallery, Washington, DC, in 2023, centered on concepts of the wind, titled "The Wind We Cannot See."

Sharon holds a BS in art education, a masters in therapeutic recreation, and a doctorate in combined studies in special education and psychology. Throughout her career, prior to retirement, she focused on the needs of individuals with intellectual disabilities and autism as a therapist, educator, and non-profit leader. Much of her work involved creative arts therapies and arts integration. She culminated her career leading the national agenda in arts education and special education in the Kennedy Center's Education Department, bringing together leaders from around the country to affect policy, research, and practice, and contributing to the National Standards in K-12 Arts Education.

She continues to work as a mentor for individuals with disabilities who demonstrate gifts in visual arts. Her work with individuals with disabilities has influenced her own art making, and she is grateful for all of the opportunities she has had to work with many creative individuals.







#### Heads up!! Franconia Government Center Show is around the corner!

While things are still a bit tentative, we wanted to get this out there for planning purposes...

- For many years now, Springfield Art Guild has hung a show at the Franconia Government Center on Franconia Road.
- For our newbies, the Franconia Government Center houses the Franconia District Supervisor's office and staff, the police station, some meeting areas, some historical exhibits and a thrift shop/bookstore. We hang our art in the space considered to be the lobby.



#### Tentatively, the dates for this show will be:

Jan. 3, 2025 Registration begins, prospectus to be sent out in a separate email

Jan. 26, 2025 Registration closes

Feb. 1, 2025 Saturday: Drop off artwork and hanging

Feb. 8, 2025: Supervisor's reception and Peoples' Choice awards

April 5, 2025 Saturday: Takedown and pick up artwork

#### Good facts to know:

- There is NO registration fee for this show! Submit info and photos on Jotform
- There is NO theme or subject requirements for this show! Artist's choice! Although only two dimensional artwork can be displayed. We only ask for submissions that have not previously been shown in a Franconia show and are suitable for family viewing.
- There is NO jury or judge for this show. The only award will be a Peoples' Choice Award, attendees at the supervisor's reception will be asked to vote for their favorites.

#### It's a great low key opportunity for artists who haven't entered too many shows to ease into it... artist's choice!

The Franconia District supervisor (Rodney Lusk for the last few years) holds an annual reception, timed during the period when our artwork is hanging on the walls, and invites SAG to participate. The supervisor and other speakers talk about the great things happening in that part of the county, and SAG, in addition to the Peoples' Choice balloting and award, holds a very popular raffle of donated small works of art. Attendees who submit a People's Choice ballot, get a raffle ticket, and hopefully go home with a treasure!
